Introduction

South Yorkshire and Humber Building Control are pleased to announce our fifth annual Building Excellence Awards.

Builders undertaking projects in Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham, Sheffield, Hull, and North Lincolnshire are eligible to take part in this prestigious Building Control Awards Scheme.

Any size of project, for which the Local Authority provides the Building Control Service, from new homes, extensions, and alterations through to commercial developments has the opportunity to scoop one of these awards.

Success in the Awards will demonstrate an organisations commitment to quality and sustainable construction, recognised throughout Local Authority Building Control and the construction industry.



Nominations

Each council's Building Control Service invites nominations for an award from projects that achieve high standards of workmanship, and where work complies with the regulations.

After judging, three schemes from each category will be invited to the finals at a gala dinner to be held on:

Thursday 19 April 2012 at the Forest Pines Hotel, Scunthorpe

Judging

A panel made up of representatives from each of the South Yorkshire & Humber authorities with an independent chair will judge the schemes.

Once the judging of the competition has taken place, strict secrecy on the outcome will be upheld to ensure the success of the awards night.

No discussions will be entered into either before or after the awards ceremony and the judges' decision is final.

The 11 awards categories will be:

1. Best Individual House
2. Best small housing development (2-10 units)
3. Best large housing development (11+ units)
4. Best social or affordable housing development
5. Best community project
6. Best domestic project
7. Best commercial building > £1million
8. Best commercial building < £1million
9. Best sustainable project
10. Best restoration and conversion
11. Best partnership with a local authority

Some categories may be split at judging stage, with an overall 'Winner of Winners' to be announced on the night.

Judging will take place based on the following criteria:

- Compliance with the Building Regulations
- Supplying/managing information
- Speed of fault rectification
- Site environment – Safety and storage of materials (so as not to be detrimental to their use)
- Accessibility and inclusive environment
- Access for people with disabilities
- Client / customer satisfaction
- Consistency of construction
- Sustainability
- Giving of notices and information
